Director Dijana Harrison and Senior Civil Engineer Peter Lockhart are members of the Southern Chapter of the Urban Development Industry of New South Wales, with Peter having been a past Southern Chapter Chairman.

TECHNOLOGY



In the past 12 months Goodmans' surveyors have taken charge of 4 Trimble Robotic Theodolites. Hand held devices, pre-programmed with crucial site data including boundaries and proposed building grids guide the roaming surveyor.

The Robotics enable the theodolite to track, measure and report directions via a radio communication link. The technology allows the surveyor to have a more 'hands-on' approach to the site survey.

Goodmans still utilise two person field crews, who now work in closer contact, enhancing the safety and communication aspects of the job.

Both Joan and Ross played an integral part in the formation of Goodmans then known as GA Goodman Surveys.
